Dear Mr. President,

I have received your invitation with thanks.

It is with pleasure that I recall our parliamentary negotiations with the student delegation last year, on which you also took part. I am sure you remember that during our meeting on the act on higher education, which was under parliamentary debate at the time, I presented to you in detail the multi-stage plans for the reorganisation of the higher education system. The Hungarian Rector's Conference also honoured us by entering into substantive talks on the reorganisation of the higher education system.

I feel that we have caused no surprises of any kind. The Government has laid its cards on the table from the day it was formed, whether with regard to the reorganisation of the pensions system, the local government system, the healthcare system, the tax system or public services. You may continue to rely on this kind of openness in the future.
